Hi! Can you briefly introduce yourself and explain why you wanted to start this account?

Hey! It's HSLOTFASHIONHQ. I started this account on the first night of last year's tour. I feel so connected to this fandom. It's one big family and I wanted to create another space for us to connect and feel safe being ourselves.

I think maximalism is something huge within this fandom. We see people in huge cowboy hats with glitter and feathers, boas, big puffy dresses, crazy patterns, big boots, sparkly dresses, wedding dresses, watermelon costumes, etc. I can go on forever. I think Harry has influenced us to be our most authentic selves.

The beauty of our fandom and the style at our shows is the versatility of the outfits. There is no uniform for HSLOT shows, we can be whoever we want to be there. Whether we wear big puffy dresses, leather suits, or t-shirts and jeans, we all are in good company and support each other.

One of the aesthetics I see a lot is Harrycore. I have no other way of describing it, but we try to emulate whatever Harry has worn and made it our own. That's why we see a lot of boas, leather, JW Anderson cardigans, cowboy hats, fruit patterns, and flared

clothing. I think one of the biggest inspirations people have taken from is Harry's Grammy performance - we spin it our own way, but leather/flare pants, a cute top, and boa is a classic that will never go out of style.

Is there one song that stands out as the inspiration for fans' tour outfits?

I think if any specific song is being shown through outfit, it might be Watemelon Sugar or Only Angel. Those two, you can see more specifically within the outfits. It's more obvious.
